


Mission activities in Nuba Mountains

Commissioning to mission in the Nuba Mountains

I always have a heart for a mission to the people of Nuba and African in general to work among them and to be a servant to them whenever they are. It was in the morning around 10:30am at Brisbane time when I went to visit Keith Black in Carina suburb southside. Where he came to pick me at the reception area to a chapel in which we had long discussion about Africa back earlier. In fact, the conversation was circulated on the comparative of mission from early missionaries period and today. Keith had indicated that many things have been changed and off course the mission has changed its directions to meet the need of people. Keith & late Roy and their team left the country of Sudan and special Nuba Mountains in 1962 under the Islamic Sudanese government restrictions which was against the foreign missionaries.

After we prayed together and said goodbye to Keith left Australia when the government of Australia led by Scott Morrison who approved me exemption of COVID-19 restrictions to go to South Sudan. Indeed, I went to South Sudan in November 2021 and then to the Nuba Mountains in Sudan. I left Australia when my family here and back home mourning for my father who passed away on October 2021 before I reach there in November at the same year. He had promise me to meet with him in Sudan and in fact, my heart was longing to meet with him

in his last days of his life on earth. Unfortunately, I was wrong, and misinterpreted his message in form of human understand and not spiritual way. And so, it was the conversation that I felt he is saying to me we will meet one day when you come to home in heaven where my eternity would be. I went to Sudan with very broken heart but at the same time rejoicing in the Lord that he went to be with the Lord, and why I am very sure about that because my father left two words for me and to us all. 1/ STAND FIRM IN CHRIST 2/ DO JUSTICE he expressed these words on video record before I reach there.

Youth conference in Lado





Prayer points

The work is ready and there are a few workers in the field to do the job among Indigenous Nuba native people of Sudan. We have conducted two conferences for three days each church and we have seen God's hand moving and touching the melted hearts. And people are thirsty for the word of God deeply and I wish we have enough time to hold six days conference in each church. However, due to the time consuming we were not able to visit other churches who have asked us for so.

Our prayer requests are as follow:

1/ pray for the mission work so that God may enable us to deliver his message to the needy soul in the Nuba Mountains.

2/ pray that next year 2023 our mission preparation can go well, and all resources needed to be available specially logistics and other materials such sound system to be on our hands.

3/ pray for the churches that booked us to do the conferences in their places in both Nuba Mountains and Khartoum. there is Presbyterian church in Angolo (Krongo) in Nuba Mountains who wants us to do the conference there three days. And there is a Presbyterian church in Khartoum Hesaesa wanted us to do the conference as well over there in 2023.

4/ We need speakers, microphones built or use with solar system and one keyboard for the mission program and this equipment are necessary and will be helpful for us a lot in delivering the services if we do own them.

5/ pray that other denominations and churches will join and partnership with us in the mission to the Nuba Mountains people and beyond.

6/ some churches have asked us to provide them with choir uniform made of African fabric and please pray that these requests will find an answer to their needs before 2023.

7/ We recently working and developing a program to do with Sunday school children in 2023 and this program is very new to be initiated in Nuba Mountains. And we pray that the materials and would be ready to be use in Sunday school conference and other resources.

8/ we are also establishing new program to educate church leaders on leadership and management in which church leaders would be able to create and have a good, equipped leaders for their congregations.

9/ lastly, we pray that God may provide 4 wheels car to help us with carrying our mission logistics and equipment including our staff and choir.

Overall, I would like to take this opportunity thank you all for your prayer and intercession that made the mission possible in 2022 and we thank you in the bottom of our hearts.
